2. Review of Minutes from 16 October 2019 Meeting	Note: Minutes of the 16 October 2019 Academic Council Meeting (Exhibit A) were emailed to council members prior to this meeting for review. <ul style="list-style-type: none">Members had no additions or corrections to minutes of previous meeting.	Dr. Ogden requested a motion to approve minutes (Exhibit A). Dr. Lakshmanaswamy motioned. Dr. Htay seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
3. GSBS – Clinical Research Certificate Program Update	Note: The GSBS post-baccalaureate certificate program in clinical research overview (Exhibit B) was emailed to council members prior to this meeting for review. <ul style="list-style-type: none">Dr. Lakshmanaswamy presented an update of the GSBS clinical research certificate program to the council.<ul style="list-style-type: none">Rules and regulations needed prior to submission.Comments and suggestions from the council are welcome.Clinical chairs and resident directors already approve of program.Completion requirement of program will include one published manuscript for each enrollee.Program designed for residents and fellows interested in clinical research.Cost for each student in program will be under \$5,000.00 for fifteen credit hours.Credits from program will not transfer to a current master's program in its present incarnation.	Dr. Lakshmanaswamy will enquire if program credits can be incorporated into a master's program so other TTUHSC El Paso schools can send students to the program and still receive credit.
4. GSBS – Research Ethics Course	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Dr. Lakshmanaswamy briefed council on the GSBS research ethics course.<ul style="list-style-type: none">Must be face-to-face – cannot be online.	Dr. Lakshmanaswamy will update council with more information in future.

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Provides an introduction to research ethics, planning research, IRB, animal trials, etc. ○ Projected length of eight hours. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Estimated implementation in 2021. 	
5. WLHSDM - Curriculum	<p>Note: Proposed WLHSDM curriculum (Exhibit C) and corresponding calendar (Exhibit D) emailed to council members prior to this meeting for review.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Dr. Woodall presented an overview of the WLHSDM curriculum. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Curriculum will be similar to PLFSOM's with the exception of dental skills being taught each day of the week. ○ Other courses in the curriculum include public health, Spanish, ethics and professionalism, and clinical practicum. ○ All courses will be pass/fail. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Council discussed how the pass/fail assessment of Spanish classes could present issues for students who wish to use their Spanish credits for other degrees as opposed to issuing letter grades. ○ PLFSOM is objective-based whereas WLHSDM will be competency-based. 	<p>Dr. Ogden called for a motion to approve updated WLHSDM curriculum (Exhibit C) with recommended changes. Dr. Htay motioned. Dr. Woods seconded. Motioned passed unanimously.</p>
6. TTUHSC El Paso Libraries – Collaborative Negotiations Group	<p>Dr. Beinhoff briefed the council about negotiations with Elsevier.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Elsevier: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ has monopoly on the e-journal subscription business, ○ has had inflexible pricing model for e-journals; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Pricing for TTUHSC El Paso up 26% from 2019. ▪ Due to price increases, TTUHSC El Paso would pay 101% of library budget for Elsevier service next year. 	<p>Dr. Beinhoff will keep council informed with pertinent updates during negotiation process.</p>

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ only lowers prices when buyer purchases more products – exams not included. ● During early 2020, all libraries will begin negotiating with Elsevier. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ All of Germany’s and Finland’s universities have canceled their contracts with Elsevier. ○ Texas universities have formed a collaboration to negotiate pricing in response to price hikes. 	
7. Review of HSCEP OP 77.XX, <i>Care Team Policy</i>	<p>Note: Proposed draft of HSCEP OP 77.XX (Exhibit E) emailed to council members prior to this meeting for review.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Introduced as proactive, early-intervention policy. ● Discussion and recommended changes during meeting included: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ §II.A: Replacing “community” with “students” to prevent confusion. ○ Including language to instruct 911 be called in case of emergency. ○ Student self-threat is no longer an involuntary withdrawal process as it is a protected disability. 	HSCEP OP 77.XX (Exhibit E) will be edited based on recommendations discussed and presented to council at future meeting for review.
8. Information Technology – Update of IT Resources	<p>Ms. Escapita presented a summary of updates highlighting IT resources (Exhibit F) to include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ improving data architecture, consolidating applications, and reducing manual work; ○ migrating systems and programs into Canvas as centralized database; ○ Banner system integration; and ○ Adobe Sign is now available and online. 	Informational presentation regarding current and pending IT projects and effects on respective departments. No action items at this time for council.
9. Other Business	no discussion	Dr. Ogden asked council if any other business needed to be discussed. Attendees put forward neither old nor new business to discuss.
